



23rd EVSSAR CONGRESS “EVSSAR still e-live”

October 1-2, 2021

GUIDELINES FOR ABSTRACTS

Deadline for submission: June 15th, 2021

1. The Scientific Committee of the 23rd EVSSAR Online Congress invites all veterinarians and professionals related to veterinary sciences to submit abstracts (related to clinical and fundamental research, including doctoral thesis, laboratorial trials, retrospective studies, case reports, etc.) on reproduction of small, laboratory, and exotic animals

2. All delegates are encouraged to submit abstracts, which will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee. Selected abstracts will be presented as short communication videos (see below).

3. The abstract should describe the objectives and results and include the following points:

- Introduction and objectives.
- Materials and methods: brief description of procedures, including statistical analysis.
- Results.
- Conclusions.

Clinical cases should include the following parts: clinical case and discussion.

4. Preparation of abstracts.

The length of abstracts must not exceed 500 words. Figures and tables should be minimal. You are allowed to upload one supporting document per abstract as an image file.

5. Abstracts should be **submitted online by June 15th, 2021.**

- Once you visit this page, you will be asked to create an account, in order to start the abstract submitting process. Should you encounter any issues, you may contact the Congress Secretariat at congressdpt@afea.gr and they will respond to you as soon as possible.

- There are detailed instructions throughout the abstract submitting process, so please make sure you follow the guidance provided by the platform during every step.
- While submitting your abstract you must indicate in the online submission form whether you prefer a poster or short oral presentation and whether you are a PhD/doctoral student, an ECAR resident or an invited speaker.

6. Abstracts will not be accepted in the following cases:

- a) If the submission date is later than June 15th, 2021
- b) If the results are not included.
- c) If the abstract is not based on the guidelines.
- d) If abstracts are submitted by e-mail instead through the online system.

7. After evaluation, the authors will be informed of the acceptance or rejection of the abstract within 4 weeks after the submission deadline. If necessary, corrections will be requested, and the abstract should be resubmitted within a second deadline. Abstracts not received by the second deadline cannot be included in the congress program or proceedings. Accepted abstracts will be presented as e-posters or short communications and all relevant guidelines a upon the acceptance of your abstract.
